32nd Annual Over the River Run



The Southern Cultural Heritage Foundation (SCHF) is very excited to be having the Over the River Run this year! Many of us are really looking forward to being able to participate in an event, especially a fun outdoor event like this one! It will take place on **Saturday**, **October 17th** at **8:00am** and begins at the Old Mississippi River Bridge located at I-20 and Washington Street.

> This unique run follows a scenic course heading west across the Mississippi River to Delta, Louisiana and then returns back to the finish line. We are so excited to be able to have this event in person which will

include a 5-mile run and a 5-mile walk! If you are not ready for the in-person event, we have you covered! We are offering a virtual choice, as well. There will be three categories in the virtual event, a 10K run, a 5K run, and a 5K walk.

Due to COVID-19, we will be limiting the number of participants allowed to register. The first 400 registered participants, in-person or virtual, will be guaranteed an awesome DryBlend OTRR Shirt. So, register early!! The entry fee is \$35 for the 5-mile race, in-person or virtual. Early registration is strongly encouraged to secure a place at the event.
